Oregon Senior Peer Outreach Goals:

We will serve up to 60 socially isolated older adults (55+) who live in rural or frontier GOBHI counties. Provide regular telephone peer support with fidelity to **Intentional Peer Support (IPS)** practice. Peer values including self-determination, respect, connection, understanding worldview, mutuality and moving forward will guide our interactions.

Collect data through evaluation to demonstrate impacts of an ongoing peer support relationship in domains such as increased hope, self-care, engagement and reducing the experience of loneliness. Senior Peer Support Specialists who place the outreach calls are older adult peers skilled in the practice of IPS.
